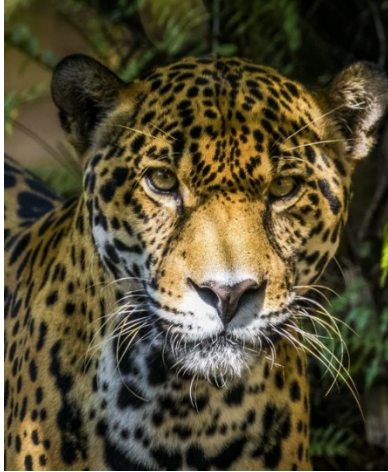

Lessons learned and good practices in strengthening national inter-agency coordination to combat wildlife trafficking

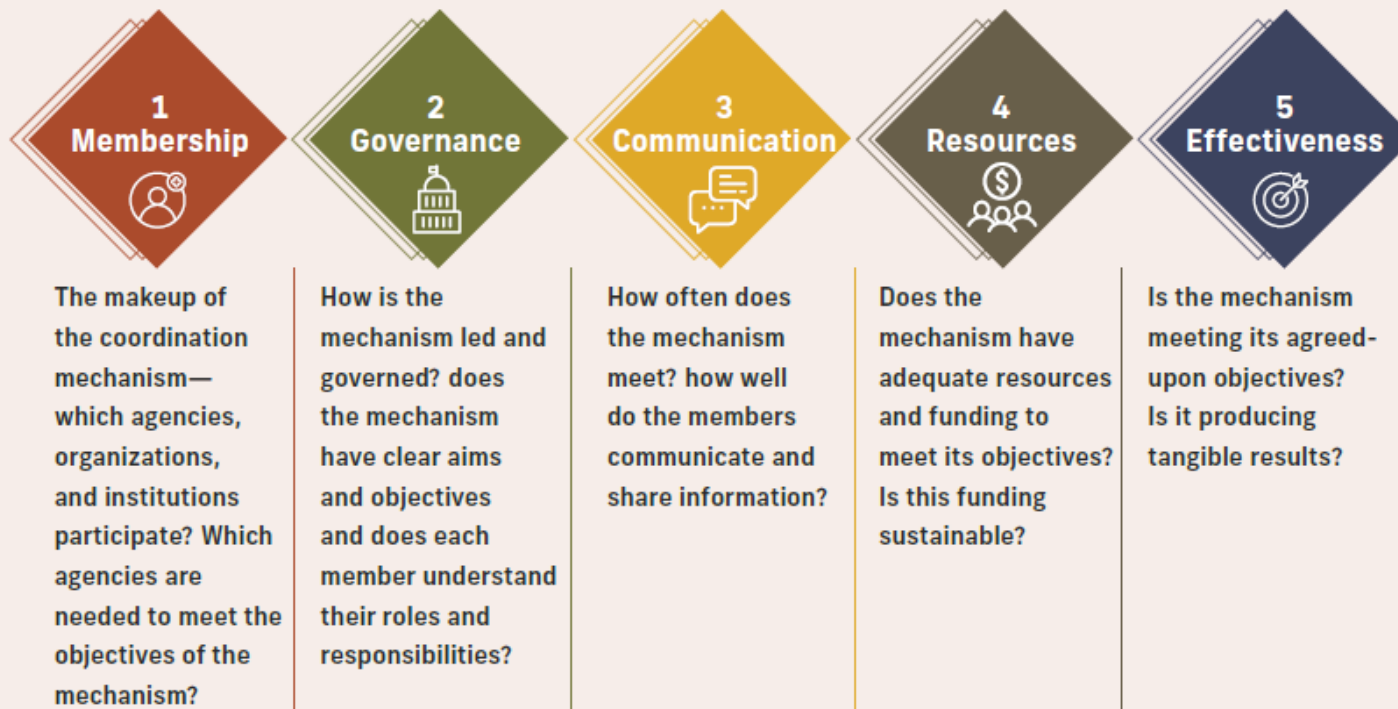


New GWP Guidance Note

Eligibility

- All GEF-eligible countries
- Terrestrial, freshwater & marine wildlife (fauna)

Cross-cutting: Social & behavioral change, knowledge management, gender, Indigenous People & Local Communities



EXPRESSION OF INTEREST PROCESS & TIMEFRAME

- **Call for EOI** issued to GEF-eligible countries through the OFPs with deadline for submission
- Countries work with their selected GEF Agencies to **complete and submit** EOI templates
- **Committee** convened by GEF Secretariat and Lead Agency to review EOIs
- Countries **notified** of final selections and requested to prepare Project **Concept Notes**
- **Program Document** (with Concept Notes) submitted to GEF Council for approval
- Full **project development**...
